**Subject** – Objection about your Cautionary Notice for Accredited **Allopathic Hospitals**

**Reference** – Your letter no. NABH/ Notification/ Cautionary/2020/3493 dated 17-12-2020

Dear Sir,

With reference to above said subject, and your cautionary letter to Allopathic hospitals, this is to bring your notice that, AYUSH doctors are duly qualified medical practitioners as like MBBS graduates with almost same syllabus and added Ayurvedic syllabus as per the ~~etc~~ and as competent and efficient as any modern graduate. Secondly, CCIM is the statutory apex body governing the Ayurvedic course across the nation, and is formed by enacting the law in the Parliament (CCIM Act 1970 vide gazette notification section 3 (ii) dated 10-08-1971. CCIM in its notification, No. 85/96-Ay.(MM) dated 30-10-1996, notified that – Institutionally qualified practitioners of Indian System of Medicine are eligible to practice Indian System of Medicine and Modern Medicine including surgery, Gynaecology etc based on their training included in syllabus" (Copy enclosed , Annexure No. 1)

Similarly, as per the Maharashtra Act No. XXVIII of 2014 amended on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2014, section 25 subclause (v) "The registered practitioners of the Indian system of Medicine holding qualifications mentioned in the PART A, A-1 , B or D of the schedule and holding post graduate qualification, shall be eligible to pursue and practice the latest knowledge, skill and technological advances to the extent of training they received in that system during the post graduation. (Copy enclosed , Annexure No. 2)

Again as per the clarification issued by the Maharashtra Council of Indian Medicine through its letter No. MCIM/1701374/2017 dated 25-01-2017, all doubts regarding our rights to practice modern medicine have been cleared (Copy enclosed, Annexure No. 3)

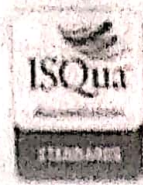

## **Cautionary Notice for NABH Accredited Allopathic Hospitals**

It has come to the notice of NABH Secretariat that some of the NABH accredited Allopathic hospitals are employing or seeking to employ AYUSH Doctors for performing clinical duties in ICUs & at other patient care areas in place of MBBS RMOs & Emergency doctors.

This is a blatant violation of NABH Standards for healthcare accreditation and very much against patient safety norms and compromise quality of modern medicine clinical care outcome.

NABH has taken a serious note of the aforementioned matter and it is reiterated that employing of AYUSH doctors in Allopathic Hospitals for writing independent orders & clinical work without supervision of allopathic doctors is not permitted. Further, in case the Allopathic hospitals are employing AYUSH doctors to work as clinical assistants, as per the applicable state laws, they should not be involved in direct patient care and should strictly follow job responsibilities as defined by hospital management. AYUSH doctors working in NABH applicant allopathy hospitals will not be considered as RMOs during the process of assessment and for the purpose of grant of accreditation.

This cautionary notice should be taken seriously by all concerned. Any violation may invite adverse decision by NABH including withdrawal of accreditation, as per policy.
