**Subject** – Regarding New MSE (Ayurveda) to be implemented by NCISM

Dear & Respected Sir

With regard to the proposed draft, I would like to suggest following things :

- 1] The provision of either or (Professor or Reader) for intake up to 60 students should be removed and it should be made as 1 Professor, 1 Reader and 1 Lecturer mandatory and for 100 intake 1 Professor 2 Reader and 3 lecturers should be made compulsory. This will improve the job prospect of the BAMS graduates who are coming in crops due to increase in number of colleges permitted by GOI.
- 2] The provision of allied subject for recruitment of teacher should be abolished once and for all as ample number of PGs of concerned subjects are available now a days. And in fact the concerned PGs are out of Job. The teachers who have completed more than 15 years in allied subject, may be continued in that subject whereas those having lesser experience should be allowed to migrate to their parent subject with their acquired experience intact.
- 3] The provision of elective subjects should be removed as it makes no sense in medical profession. The subject like Padartha Vigyan should not find a place in syllabus as it has no relation with any medical science. If not completely removed then at least the 'Study of various Darshanas' should be removed from Padarth Vigyan subject as this darshanik philosophy has no relation with medical science.
- 4] The 'Sanskrit' subject should be kept out of theory examination and should be limited to viva voce examination only.
- 5] The subject 'Ayurved Itihas' should be a separate paper of 100 marks as history is important part of any civilization, science and the country. Ayurveda had history

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from stone age, medieval period to modern times. Many legends have contributed richly in the Ayurvedic literature. Hence, it should be taught in detail.

6] The described **surgeries** for *Chhidrodara* (Intestinal perforation) and *Baddhgudodara* (Intestinal obstruction), plastic surgeries like Nasa Sandhan (Rhinoplasty), Karna sandhan (earoplasty) and cosmetic plastic surgeries, newer form of Agnikarma i.e. Laser which have not found a space in the earlier list of 60 allowed surgeries of earstwhile CCIM. Hence, now it should be clearly mentioned and allowed.

7] The provision of **Internal assessment examinations** should be removed as it makes the students *Pariksharthi* only and not shape a doctor in them. Instead of this, a suitable compilation project work should be given to them which will make them to refer the various books of Ayurveda and accordingly they will come to know about the vast literature of Ayurveda. Otherwise they may not come to know about these books and will read only the syllabus books. Only the final examination should be taken by the concerned university to bring seriousness. More focus should be given on practical training of the students.

8] As **there are no patients** in almost all the private Ayurvedic colleges, all these colleges should be asked to make compulsory MOU with Government District or PHC hospitals for practical training of the students or Parallel modern hospital should be allowed to run in the same campus along with Ayurvedic hospitals to increase the number of patients. It is in the interest of all that we accept the reality sooner than later.

9] After post graduation, under the subject of '**Roga Nidana**' following new course should be started by NCISM itself and respective universities should be asked to implement these courses for Ayurvedic PGs of Roga Nidana:

A] Certificate in X- Ray Diagnosis (1 Year)

B] Certificate in CT/MRI Diagnosis (1 Year)

C] Certificate in USG Diagnosis (1 Year)

D] Certificate in 2 D Echo Diagnosis (1 Year)



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- E] Certificate in ECG & EEG Diagnosis (1 Year)
- F] Certificate in Histopathology Diagnosis (1 Year)
- G] Diploma in Endoscopic Diagnosis (2 Year)
- H] Diploma in Radio Diagnosis (2 Year)
- I] Diploma in Electrophysiological Diagnosis (2 Years)

10] Last but not least the **regular and at par salary of the teachers in private Ayurvedic colleges** should be ensured by the NCISM itself as it is in accordance with the principles of 'equality' of the constitution. For equal amount of work on equal designation, there should be equal amount of pay. Moreover, the private college managements does not pay it from their pockets but from the fees collected from the students which is as decided by the Fees Regulating Authority (FRA). When FRA regulates the fees depending upon the amount paid on salary of the staff, then what is the problem in giving the at par salary to the teaching staff?

NCISM must find a way for this long pending demand of the teachers due to unfulfillment of which there is once again possibility of compromised services. Whatever you do, barring few no private college pay on time (You can verify the fact from the salary deposited in the bank). To regularize this, NCISM should ask the private colleges to deposit the Year's Salary amount of the teachers from the fees of the student directly in the account of NCISM which then can be distributed to the teachers every monthly. This should be done on priority basis when so much is expected from the teachers to deliver.
