With reference to above said subject, This is to again bring your notice that that before the establishment of separate PG course in 'Chhaya and Vikiran' and even after the closure of this course for unknown reasons, the PGs of Roga Nidana were teaching entire radiology to the UG and PG students as per the syllabus framed by CCIM both for UG and PGs of Roga Nidana and Chhaya Vikiran subject. And now Roga Nidana PGs are not considered by CCIM for recommending their name to be included in the provisions of the PCPNDT act to the Health Ministry, Government of India.

If you are planning to restart the P.G. in Chhaya Vikiran Vigyan, again you will have to accept Roga Nidan PGs as their guide. Then It will be funny situation in a sense that student will be able to practice radiology but guide cannot. Hence, to avoid being in this ridiculous and unlawful situation, kindly write to one more letter to the Health secretary of GOI to include the MD Roga Nidana peoples under the provisions of PCPNDT act.

Sir,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that this council has received representations of Dr Vishal Gupta, National President, Imaging and Radiological association regarding Registration of Ultrasound Clinic/Imaging Centre run by Radiologist having Post Graduate Qualification in Imaging and Radio Diagnosis recognized by IMCC Act, 1970 to be registered under the PC&PNDT Act, 1994.

The M.D (Ay) in Chhaya avum Vikiran Vigyan (Imaging and Radio Diagnosis) is a recognized Post Graduate Qualification of Radiology under the IMCC Act, 1970 accordingly Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India has granted permission to various Ayurvedic medical colleges to conduct this new Post Graduate course of radiology from session 2012-13 onwards under the provision of section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.

The syllabus/curriculum of this Post Graduate qualification is prescribed by the Central Council of Indian Medicine with the previous sanction of the Govt. of India which includes all the aspects of the Radiology subjects like X-ray, Ultrasound, C.T Scan, M.R.I., Mammography, Angiography, PET Scan etc (copy enclosed).

This PG qualification i.e. M.D (Ay) Chhaya avum Vikiran Vigyan (Imaging and Radio Diagnosis) recognized under IMCC Act, 1970 can be treated as equivalent to the PG qualification i.e. M.D Radiology recognized by the IMC Act, 1956.

The doctors holding this M.D (Ay) Chhaya avum Vikiran Vigyan (Imaging and Radio Diagnosis) recognized under the IMCC Act, 1970 and registered under the Council of Indian Medicine of their respective states are eligible for getting registration under the Pc & PNDT Act, 1994 to set up or being employed in a medical imaging centre/ultrasound diagnostic centre.

Therefore, you are requested to amend the section 2(P) of The Pre-Conception and Pre Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition Of Sex Selection) Act 1994 by adding the qualification viz. "MD(Ay) Chhaya avum Vikiran Vigyan (Imaging and Radio Diagnosis) recognized by IMCC Act, 1970" under the definition of "Sonologist or Imaging specialist".

Sir/Madam,


With reference to subject mentioned above, I am directed to say that this council is in receipt of proposal regarding the Public notice issued by MOHFW GOI for proposed amendments in the provisions of PC-PNDT Act. The matter was placed before the Executive Committee held on 27.08.2018 at CCIM office and the **Executive Committee considered the matter and decided to write to Ministry of Health and Family welfare :-**

1. To include the degree of MS / MD (Ayurveda) Striroga and Prasutitantra / M.D. (Siddha) Sool, Magalir Maruthuvam/ M.D. (Unani) Amraze Niswan wa Iilmul Qabala; in the definition of Gynaecologist of PCPNDT Act or Allowing them to 6 months training (as declared by the Central Govt. in Proposed amendment).
2. To confer the rights of implementation as well as the eligibility according to the State acts in respective states so that appropriate authority for the Declaration of qualified person shall lie within purview of State Government.
3. Also to consider MS / MD (Ayurveda) Striroga and Prasutitantra / M.D. (Siddha) Sool, Magalir Maruthuvam/ M.D. (Unani) Amraze Niswan wa Iilmul Qabala; under following rules.
  - a) Page 3 (f) - definition of Gynaecologist-
  - b) Rule 3 Nomenclature of the six months training in Ultrasonography
  - c) Rule 6 Eligibility of training
  - d) Rule 8 Selection of students
  - e) Rule 9 Changed criteria to be made prospective
  - f) Rule 14 Validity of training certificateWhile amending the provisions of PC-PNDT Act

Therefore, you are requested to look into the matter and include above said suggestion while amending the provisions of PC-PNDT Act.
